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Enduro Rules

(July 2, 2009 – Rules added for the Figure 8 Race, Boat / Trailer Race, Van Gauntlet Race and Skid Plate Race.)

1. **Entries** – For the 100 lap enduro, there must be a minimum of 20 cars to hold the race. Less than 20 cars the race will not be ran.
2. **Registration** – A driver registration form must be filled out prior to the race. The forms are located at the pit office. All information must be filled out to be eligible to race.
3. **Eligible Vehicles** – Event is open to American or Foreign manufactured street cars and min vans, no convertibles or pick ups. These vehicles are to remain stock for make, mode and year with the exception of the modifications that follow. The engine, rear end (or transaxle) and transmission must remain stock. NO race cars, street stocks, pure stocks or similar.
4. **Entrants** – All drivers must be a minimum of 16 years of age. One passenger in the front seat is optional.
5. **All Participants** – No radio communication allowed (one way radio, cell phone, racerecievers of any kind).
6. **Appearance** – Lettering must be in good taste. We encourage theme cars (Spiderman, Police, Sponge Bob).
7. **Number & Starting Position** – Please put your own number on your car to be scored by your scorer. Your starting position will be determined by a draw or first come.
8. **Battery** – If battery is relocated it must be contained in a marine type container and securely fastened.
9. **Body** – All cars must retain their stock appearance. No cutting, chopping, channeling or shortening allowed. NO cutting of wheel wells or fenders.
10. **Dash, Firewall & Interior** – Non-Metal interior trim and seals not used must be removed. There must be a firewall between the driver's compartment and the trunk. The left side door is recommended to leave interior panel for protection or if removed, add padding.
11. **Doors** – All doors must be welded shut. At least (4) 1 inch welds per door. Doors can also be chained (if not welded) minimum of 1/8" chain loops and minimum of 3/8" bolts with 2 chains on each door.
12. **Engine** – Must be stock that make and model and in its original mounts.
13. **Gas Tank** – Gas tank in original position, no rusted straps, if so add extra. If not in original position, it must be in the trunk and strapped with at least (4) 1" straps. Gas tanks must be secure and no leaks allowed. If

gas tank is mounted in the rear trunk then the rear firewall between the driver and gas tank must be completely sealed with sheet metal or aluminum sheet.

14. **Glass & Trim** – All glass and plastic must be removed. This includes all chrome, lights, mirrors, reflectors, trim and inside door panels must be removed. Trunk and inside of car must be swept clean. No inside or outside mirrors. All knobs, handles, decks, unnecessary upholstery and seats must be removed. A heavy duty screen with a maximum 2"x2" screen must cover the original windshield area. A center support from dash to the roof should also be added for support. Must be pop riveted or welded from post to post full length of windshield area. No chicken wire or storm door screen.
15. **Safety** - All entrants must wear full faced helmet. Fire racing suit recommended. Gloves are recommended. If not wearing a racing suit, jeans, long shirt or jacket and boots are highly recommended.
16. **Seat & Seat Belts** – Seat must be securely mounted. Lap and shoulder belts securely mounted and in working condition. It is highly recommended that a rear seat support for seats be added.
17. **Suspension** – Must remain **absolutely STOCK** for that make and model.
18. **Tires & Wheels** – Maximum wheel width 8". No racing tires.
19. **Roll Cage** – A Roll Cage **IS STONGLY RECOMEDED FOR YOUR SAFTEY**. If you choose to have a roll cage, it must consist of four point cage or continuous hoops, Minimum 1.50" O.D. tubing with wall thickness of at least .095" for main cage, low carbon or mild steel recommended.. Minimum of 3 door bars welded to OEM frame on both sides. If you nee help with your cage, please contact the track, Slader Racecars (Muskogee), Syclone Racecars (Haskell) or your local race car builder.
20. **Scoring** – Each car must provide his or her scorer. Scoring will be located in the main Grand stands. Please come with multiple pens and something hard to write on. (ie; clipboard).

21. **Rules for Figure 8 Races, Boat & Trailer Race, Van Gauntlet Race and Skid plate race.** All Enduro style rules apply for these races with the following additions or additions.

- a. Figure 8 Races need no changes. Enduro style cars.
- b. Boat and Trailer Race - Enduro style car or truck to be used. Boat with or without Trailer needs to be chained to the rear of the car or truck to be pulled or drug behind. The winner with the most laps and the most of their boat wins the race. Bumping is encouraged to knock out the competitor's boat.
- c. Van Gauntlet Race – Van Enduro race but with passengers. And the passengers get five gallon buckets or fruit to hurl at the competition during the race! Must be some form of a Van.
- d. Skid Plate Race – Enduro style car but each car will have the rear wheels removed and replaced with steel plates. This will cause loss of control, making it a great challenge for the drives and fun for the fans.
